## **Literacy Starter 2- Adjectives**

An **adjective** is a word which **describes**, or tells us more about a *noun*.

For example- The **hungry** boys slurped their **watery** soup into their **little** mouths.

**Hungry** is an **adjective** because it describes the *noun*, the *boys*. **Watery** is an **adjective** as it describes the *soup* and **little** is an **adjective** as it describes the boys' *mouths*.
