Literacy Starter - Adverbs

Adverbs are words that add meaning to verbs (*ad*-verb) in the same way adjectives add meaning to nouns. In many cases you can create an adverb by adding an **ly** ending to an adjective.

The adjective *slow* becomes the adverb *slowly*

If the word already ends in an L another L is added-

The adjective *beautiful* becomes the adverb *beautifully*

Words ending in y sometimes convert to ily.

The adjective *weary* becomes the adverb *wearily*.

For the following five adjectives, convert them to adverbs and write five separate sentences that use the adverb.

Eg. Adjective- rapid

- Dodie consumed the carrot *rapidly*.
