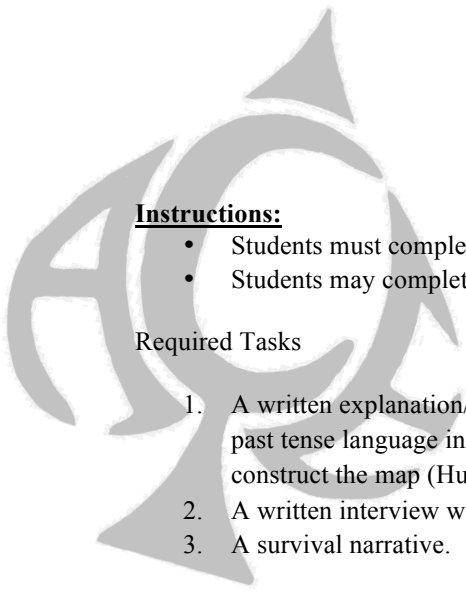

Required Tasks

1. A written explanation/ reflection on the map construction process. This piece is to be written in past tense language in first person perspective. The aim is to explain the processes used in order to construct the map (Humanities CAT 1) and reflect on the entire process.
2. A written interview with a survivor.
3. A survival narrative.

Extension Tasks

1. Using your iPad, film the interview and edit it using an app. Present your interview in one complete piece.
2. Using your iPad, create a movie trailer for Hatchet.
