Creative	<p>Short Story- Create a short story (500 words minimum) which also focuses on the development of one of the following themes from the novel;</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➢ Fear and Suffering ➢ Resilience ➢ Survival ➢ Loss 	<p>Diary Entry – Select a part of the novel where another character features in the plot development. Write a diary entry (250 words minimum) from the perspective of an alternate character at that point in the novel.</p>	<p>Story Board/ Comic Strip – Create a story board or comic strip of at least six frames. You may choose to represent the development of a character or theme from the novel. Each frame must have an explanation in the form of a caption (100 words minimum)</p>
Informative	<p>Report - Research the Nazi practice of book burning. Create a newspaper article which addresses:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➢ Who? ➢ What? ➢ When? ➢ Where? ➢ Why? ➢ How? <p>Make sure you have an attention grabbing headline! (300 words min)</p>	<p>Character Analysis - Examine a character of your choice from the novel. Think about the theme of resilience. How does your character contribute to this theme? Do they demonstrate resilience in the face of hardship? Or do they give up when things are difficult? Outline your character's personality traits. Do these traits result in them being successful of unsuccessful? Use examples from the novel to explain what you mean. (200 words min)</p>	<p>Holocaust Report- Using the information gathered from the Holocaust Webquest, construct a short report in which you explain <i>what</i> the holocaust was, <i>when</i> it occurred, <i>who</i> was involved, <i>where</i> it happened and <i>how</i> it happened. The report will use subheadings to present the information. A bibliography must be submitted with this report. (Minimum- 100words)</p>
Persuasive	<p>Review – Write a book review for the novel ‘Once’. Provide an overview of the novel including:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➢ Author/Publisher / publication date ➢ Plot ➢ Main characters ➢ Key themes <p>Make sure you include your recommendation for readers and explain why you would suggest others read this novel, or why not. Give reasons to justify your recommendation. (300 words min)</p>	<p>Letter – Write a letter to Adolf Hitler pretending that you are Felix immediately after he discovers that the Nazis are burning books. Have Felix explain to Hitler why books are so important and convince him that he should stop burning books immediately. (200words min)</p>	<p>Book Trailer – Create a book trailer for the novel ‘Once’, persuading other people to read it. Ask Mrs Lobato how to do this in your next library lesson! Be creative! (100 words min)</p>
