Collective nouns

Collective nouns are words used to define a group of objects. Although primarily applied to animals, collective nouns can be used for people, inanimate objects, concepts or other things.

The most common collective nouns are words such as swarm, herd, flock or pack, can be used for many subjects, while yet others are specific to a single species of animal or other object. Eg.

A swarm of bees

A herd of cattle.

A *flock* of geese.

A pack of wolves.

A murder of crows.
